

2018 Display Space Information

Owners of all types of wooden boats, novice or professional boat-builders, artisans of boat building related crafts, etc. are welcome to bring their craft(s) to display during the weekend. The Waterfront Wooden Boat Display is a great opportunity for boat builders and wooden boat enthusiasts and owners to gather and share insight about their watercraft.

Professional builders should note that the intent of the Boat Show is to celebrate the craft of wooden boat building. While boat building "services" may be presented during the show, the sale of boats/paddles on campus is only allowed if done as a consignment sale during the Boats-To-Tools Auction (please contact Program Director for arrangements).

Indoor space during the Wooden Boat Show is limited to programs and demonstrations. Accordingly, display space is limited to outdoors. Boat owners are encouraged to bring saw horses, boat cradles and display stands as well preferred method for securing the boats overnight. There is limited space for on-campus display of boats so register early to reserve your space!
