

Build Your Own Kayak: Stitch and Glue July 13-19, 2020

Students can choose from 7 different options to better suit their style and needs. Please indicate your preference at the time of registration.

Wood Ducks are great for lakes, rivers and calm harbors. Many are used for touring a specific body of water, photography or fishing because they are wider and offer more room for the paddler.

Shearwaters are 'sea kayaks'. They are great for the same areas as wood ducks, but are shaped to be able to handle and track better in waters such as Lake Superior. Shearwaters are good for touring and photography - but don't handle as well if you plan to fish.
