

Our mission is to enrich lives and build community by teaching traditional northern crafts in a studentcentered learning environment that inspires the hands, the heart, and the mind.

OUR STORY

North House was founded in 1997 by a small handful of inspired locals passionate about traditional craft and cooperative learning. When we published the first catalog of 23 courses (including Inuit kayak building, Scandinavian bowl carving, and canoe paddle making), North House didn't yet have a home—or even a classroom. However, two old Forest Service buildings on the harbor serendipitously became available, and North House settled in and began building a campus.

Campus has changed and expanded over the years, but those two original buildings—the Red Building and the Blue Building—are still at its heart. North House has thrived over the ensuing two decades, and now hosts over 350 classes and 3,000 students per year, and connects students and instructors from all over the state, country, and world.

OUR VALUES

PEOPLE: North House's mission is rooted in people. Our warm welcome, open-to-all programs, egalitarian engagement, and multi-generational commitment seek to build a community of respect, individuality, and appreciation. Our programs empower and affirm—celebrating curiosity, opening doors to the world, and nurturing self-discovery.

PLACE: North House's vibrant efforts are directly connected to the northern landscape and the place we call home. Our programs, community, and mission are at their best when accented by Lake Superior's horizon and affirmed by the seasons of the North. Each journey to campus is like a pilgrimage, filled with stories and experiences that rejuvenate the spirit.

CRAFT: North House's commitment to traditional crafts provides a powerful linkage between people and resources and connects the past, the present, and the future. Maintaining and perpetuating the future of craft, celebrating time-tested methods, exploring the world's need for sustainable solutions —each has and needs a place at North House.

CULTURE: North House pursues integrity and quality at every level. From daily operations to long-term planning, we pursue our mission with pride and purpose. Our institutional lifestyle reflects our commitment to craft, to community, and to the joy of hands-on learning.

WHAT IS A **FOLK SCHOOL?**

Folk schools emphasize learning for the sake of learning. There are no exams, no credits, and no term papers. As much as our courses teach a particular skill (timber framing, basketmaking), they also encourage lifelong learning. This type of learning environment is inspired by Scandinavian folkehøjskolers (folk high schools).




Our focus at North House is born largely from our location. In the northwoods of Minnesota, on the shore of Lake Superior, we emphasize traditional northern craft.

Five basic tenets guide all of our classes and programs:

- Create a rich, positive environment that inspires lifelong learning in a non-competitive environment
- Promote and preserve the knowledge, skills, crafts, and stories of the past and present
- Help students recognize and develop their creativity, talents, and interests in a student-centered environment that affirms individual differences
- Foster the concept of intergenerational learning
- Provide creative and meaningful opportunities for individuals, families, and groups

In discovering the cultural heritage of the North, our students integrate the technologies of the past with those of today, expanding their personal perspective and elucidating both the present and the future.

SAIL LAKE SUPERIOR ABOARD HJØRDIS

The flagship of the Grand Marais Harbor, Hjørdis shares the name of the mythical Norse goddess of war. Take a trip on this 50' traditionally-rigged steel schooner and gain access to both the largest lake in the world and experience Grand Marais as it was approached in the centuries before Highway 61 — from the water.

Pricing and Details

DAILY SAILS: Sails will be approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes. The rate is \$60/passenger.

SUNSET SAILS: Sunset sails are approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes. The rate is \$65/passenger.

The minimum number of passengers on any sail is 3; you will have the option to pay for an additional passenger if the minimum is not met. There are additional fees of approximately \$3 per ticket built-in to our booking system.

Departure times vary based on date of reservation and sunset time. Hjørdis has a 6 passenger capacity.

Reservations

Reservations can be made online up to one hour before the scheduled sail. Beyond that, call North House for availability. Per Coast Guard regulations, we can accommodate up to 6 guests per sail. Regardless of age (2 months old to 102 years old), each passenger counts towards our 6 guest limit, and therefore must be registered.

THE HISTORY OF HJØRDIS

The story of Hjørdis starts in a backyard near Detroit, Michigan in the early 1970s. Kenneth Woodward, a General Motors machinist and general foreman, bought plans from naval architect Thomas Colvin to build his Gazelle design, a 42' junk-rigged schooner. Seven years and over 6,000 hours later, Kenneth splashed the boat and named it after his mother: Hjørdis. He and his wife Katey spent the next decade living aboard and sailing Hjørdis off the Florida coast. Fast forward to 1997 when Hjørdis was sold and eventually ended up on Lake Superior on the docks of a fledgling folk school. Given the rich history of schooners on Lake Superior, the North House board saw the intriguing possibilities of having a "floating classroom," and the Hjørdis became a part of the school.

- Local Discount: 25% discount on tuition for full-time Cook County residents

North House interns spend months immersed in the joyful, busy, and creative work of our folk school. Days are filled with coursework, projects to explore the inner workings of an educational non-profit, campus hosting and logistical wrangling, and countless moments to learn from students and instructors excited about craft.
