Printed Resources Work Group

Help support the Communications and Marketing Manager with all of the signage and print resources needed to keep the event running smoothly! Join Rae behind the scenes in the staff office for laminating, stapling, and folding.

Physical requirements: able to sit for several hours, folding pamphlets, laminating, and stapling

Set-up/Take-down crews

Physically active individuals who aren't afraid to get their hands dirty to make campus shine. Duties include assisting with set-up and clean-up activities (cleaning campus, moving boats, lights, tables, sweeping, setting up tents, etc.). Work Study credit applies.

Physical requirements: capable of lifting heavy objects, standing for the duration of the shift, climbing ladders, etc.
